This was in addition to our normal monthly donations of: £ 200 Saturday Friendship Group working with the homeless in Leamington, £ 100 Warwick District Foodbank, £ 50 Housing, help, Hospitality (Kenilworth) helping formerly trafficked women as well as our variable monthly contributions to mission hospitals in Kenya and Uganda.
