Deanery Visitation: Our Visitation will be on 2nd and 3rd March carried out by Canon Paul Fitzpatrick, our Episcopal Vicar. He will arrive at about 4pm on Saturday for a meeting at 4.15pm with the Pastoral Council. This will be followed at 5.15pm by an opportunity for other members of the Finance Committee to also meet to talk about the present state of the parish.

On Sunday morning after the 10am Mass there will be coffee as usual and from 11.15-11.55am an open meeting for everyone who can stay.

After the evening Mass there will be an open meeting (as in the morning) from about 6.20-6.50pm.

A very early 'Easter Fayre' will take place on **Sunday 17th March** following on from the Morning Mass, in the Hall and around the church grounds.
