WELCOME TO MASS: If you are a visitor, or a new arrival in the area, do say hello to Fr Stephen, Deacon Paul or Fr Kevin. There is tea and coffee and conversation available after both Masses on Sundays in the hall.

This Sunday is designated the Sunday of the Word of God, under the theme: 'the word of Christ dwells among you.' (Col 3:16) Observed each year on the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, this day invites us to reflect on, celebrate, and share the Word of God in their daily lives. The celebration was established by Pope Francis in his 2019 Apostolic Letter *Aperuit illis*, emphasizing the essential connection between the Risen Lord, Christian communities, and Sacred Scripture. The Pope called on all believers to make the Word of God a living presence in their hearts, guiding their actions and inspiring their witness.

In today's Gospel we have a clear example of this—the Word made flesh speaks a word and the first apostles respond, beginning their life's work of evangelisation and witness. Christ's message of 'Repent and believe' is taken to heart and that simple summary of Christian life should be, as Pope Francis indicates, alive within us.
